Aims

To promote positive behaviour, mutual respect, and responsibility.

To provide clear guidance on unacceptable behaviour and consequences.

Expectations

- Show respect to all staff, volunteers, and students.
- Listen carefully and follow instructions.
- Use kind and inclusive language.
- Take care of school property and learning spaces.

Unacceptable Behaviour

- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination.
- Physical or verbal aggression.
- Disruption of learning.
- Damage to property.

Consequences

Behaviour concerns will be addressed in stages:

1. Verbal reminder.
2. Meeting with parent/guardian.
3. Formal warning from leadership.
4. Exclusion from activities/events in serious or repeated cases.

Review

This policy will be reviewed annually.
